Activity Centre for registration, but there is no heating! There is a 1.5k (20
minute walk) from the Brownsea Island jetty to the Activity Centre (SZ016876).**

Fees: £5 which includes the boat trip! As the boat can only hold a
limited number the event is restricted to 35 competitors. To reserve
