Lord Swaything purchased Townhill Park in 1897 as a country residence for his eldest son and heir, Louis Montagu. Louis became the third Baron Swaything in 1911.

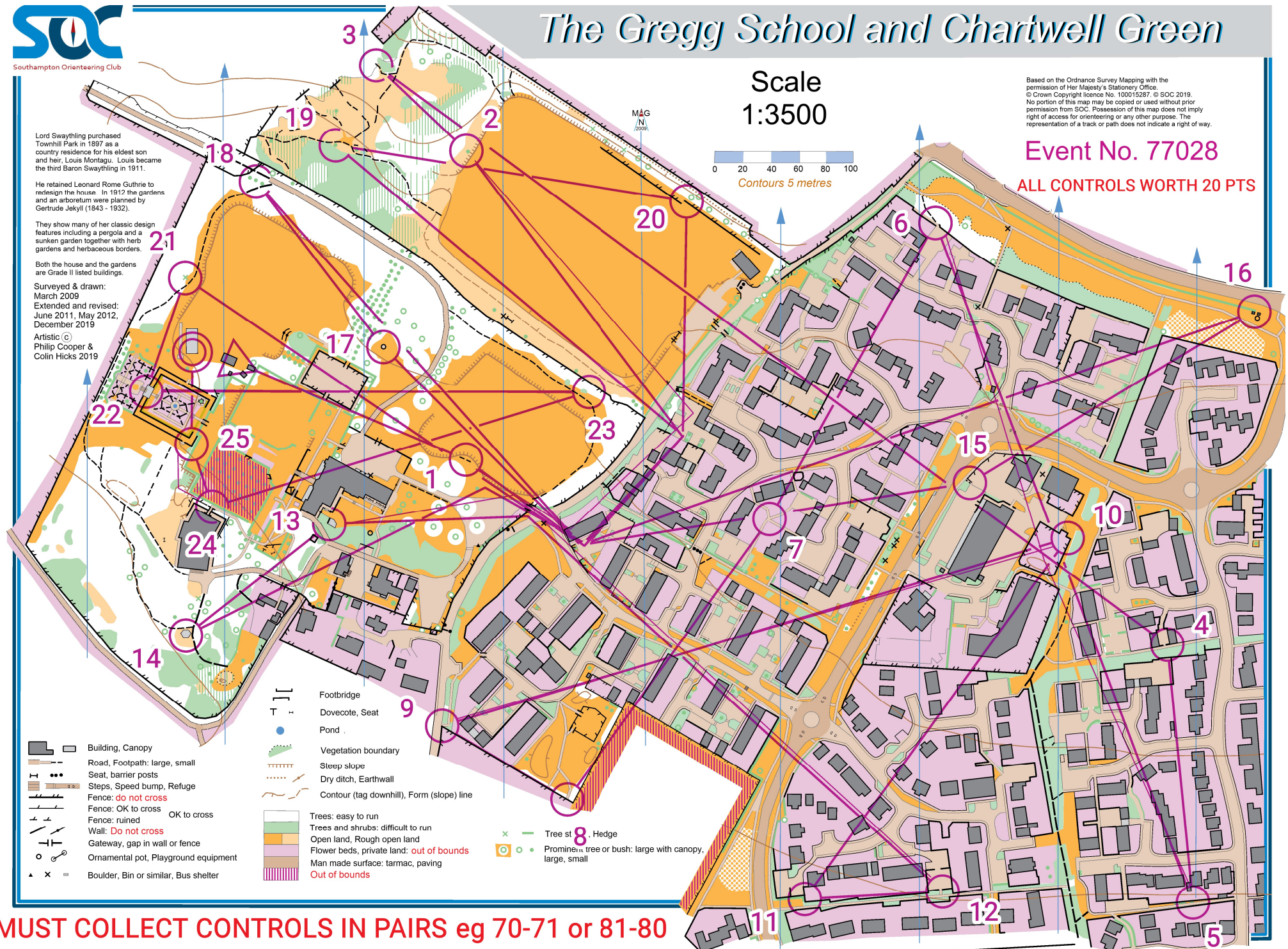
He retained Leonard Rome Guthrie to redesign the house. In 1912 the gardens and an arboretum were planned by Gertrude Jekyll (1843 - 1932).

They show many of her classic design features including a pergola and a sunken garden together with herb gardens and herbaceous borders.

Both the house and the gardens are Grade II listed buildings.
