



Poole Town Race Final Details

A Southern England Orienteering Urban League (SEOUL)

Sunday 18th June 2017

Venue: Poole Park. BH15 2SF. East end, by Copse Close.

Parking: Most roads around where we are based (Copse Close) have free parking on

Sundays. But if full, the Pay and Display at the Civic Centre BH15 2RU is only

£1.50 for the whole day on a Sunday.

Terrain: Flat urban running around Poole. Terrain will include the network of alleys in

the old town and Poole Quay. Junior Courses 5 & 6 will use Poole Park only.

Map: 1:4,000 overprinted. Map updated 2017.

A3 size for courses 1-4; A4 for 5-6.

Please note that several of the senior courses use butterfly loops so make sure you visit the controls in the correct order. Also in places the background map makes the control numbers slightly difficult to read so check carefully.

MAPPER'S NOTE: - Fence tags have been omitted where they would compromise legibility of the map.

As an aid to navigation – and to make some of the narrower alleyways easier to see – the 'forbidden to cross' line symbols for fence, wall or hedge may be used as the boundary to olive green 'out of bounds' areas. The symbol usually shows the prevalent type of boundary that the competitor sees when passing by. More generally – and particularly in the residential areas – the pavement edge symbol is used.
