



# **Christchurch Night League Race** **Final Details**

**Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019**

- Venue:** Ye Olde George Inne, 2A Castle Street, Christchurch, BH23 1DT . We have use of a separate room at the back of the Pub's courtyard.
- Parking:** Most roads around where we are based have very little free parking, even in the evenings. Suggest you use either the Waitrose Car Park (BH23 1QD) at the end of the By-Pass or the Civic Offices Car Park along Bridge Street (BH23 1AZ). Both are an easy 10 minute walk from the pub. They charge around £1.00 before 7.00 p.m. then £2.00 to cover the period after 7.00 p.m.
- Terrain:** Flat urban running around the historic town of Christchurch. Terrain will include the network of alleys in the old town, the Quay, local housing and some areas of open grass. There will also be some footpaths which could be wet if the weather in the preceding week is inclement.
- Map:** 1:5,000 overprinted. New Map surveyed January 2019.  
A3 size.
- Timing:** S.I. Electronic timing. SI-card (dibber) hire £1.
- Courses:** A One Hour Score Course using Odds and Evens. Controls have varying points and these are marked on the map as well as on the Control Descriptions. I believe the optimum route should be around 11 km.
- Times:** Registration: 6.00 p.m. onwards.  
Starts: 6.15 to 7.00 p.m.  
Courses Close: 8.00 p.m.
- Fees:** Seniors £5.00, Juniors £3.00. Juniors must be accompanied by an adult.
- Safety:** Throughout the town there will be members of the public so please take care at all times not to run into them. Hi-Viz tops to be worn. Juniors to be accompanied. And please don't fall into the river as we don't have any qualified Lifeguards on the team!
- Facilities** Food & drink – Please support the pub who are not charging us for use of the room. Toilets in the Pub
