



Queens and Kings Night League

Final Details

Monday 4th March 2019

Venue: Queen's Park Golf Club, Woodpecker Cafe, Bournemouth GR SZ106933
Postcode: BH8 9BY

Parking: Free Parking (and no football match!)

Terrain: Roughly 60% Park/Golf Course – including a few wooded areas - and 40% Urban, including some controls in the grounds of JP Morgan. We are being allowed access to their land on strict instructions that we respect the marked OOB areas. There may be some JPM traffic within the grounds – please give it priority.

Map: 1:6,000 overprinted, size A3. New Map surveyed January 2019 primarily by Julie Astin, assisted by Bill Brown. There are still a few areas to be re-surveyed but these should not affect your navigation or route choices.

Timing: S.I. Electronic timing. SI-card (dibber) hire £1.

Courses: A 1-Hour Score Course using Odds and Evens. Controls have varying points and these are marked on the map as well as on the Control Descriptions. On the map, the CD's are ordered by points value – highest to lowest – while on the loose CD's they are ordered by control code.
There are 250 points on both odds and evens. I believe the optimum route should be around 11 km.
For those not wishing to qualify for the Night League, a straight 60-minute Score can be run.

Times: Registration: 6.00 – 6.30 p.m.

Starts: 6.30 (or when dark enough) to 7.15 p.m.

Courses Close: 8.15 p.m.

The buffet will be served at around 8.15/8.30 and the Trophy Presentations at around 9pm.

Fees: Seniors £5.00, Juniors £3.00. Juniors must be accompanied by an adult.

Safety: Hi-Viz tops to be worn. Juniors to be accompanied. Crossing from Queens to the urban area and Kings Park must only be made via the two marked underpasses.

Facilities Hot Buffet for those who ordered it. There will be some other options available from the bar.
